<u>PE Kit to be worn to school:</u> Yellow PE t-shirt, black shorts, plimsolls / trainers, dark coloured jogging bottoms and school jumper when weather is colder.

PLEASE MAKE SURE ALL YOUR CHILD'S UNIFORM AND EQUIPMENT ARE CLEARLY MARKED WITH THEIR NAME.

Jewellery - The children are allowed to wear a watch and, if they have their ears pierced, one pair of small stud earrings which must be removed or covered. No other jewellery should be worn. All jewellery MUST be removed at home for PE.

Your child should read every day. Please read at least 5 times per week. This can include reading books, magazines, comics, newspapers.

English

We will be looking at story and non-fiction writing and linking it to rainforests.



We will also be looking at different types of poetry related to Rainforests and Christmas and non-chronological reports linked to our Forest School sessions.

Science
